## Awareness of Dyslexia

Dyslexia is a term we hear in dealing with children. But one of the problems is people think they know what it means and, in general, we do not. Jay Leno announced he was dyslexic many times on his TV show. This has its good points as well as bad points. On the good side, it brought about some awareness of the issue. On the bad side, many people would say it cannot be that bad if Jay Leno still became a multi-millionaire while dealing with it.

Educator and Dyslexia specialist, Kelly Steinke, recently published an article in GRADE GMAD discussing neuro-diversity. Simply stated, some educators use this term to mean there is a wide range in a mental health issue. We hear it most often with Autism and ADHD, meaning everyone is different and the issue has vast ranges on the affects the condition has on the children.

Many people you ask do not realize that in schools, dyslexia comprises 80% of all learning disabilities. It is visible through FMRI imaging in neurological research. Yet some places do not like this term. The testing shows as Steinke writes "Dyslexics have brain wiring in the language processing center of the brain and that they are different activating pat-

terns within the brain while they are reading". This is one of those things that parents must realize if your child has this diagnosis, that is an issue to deal with, not to be embarrassed by.

Ask someone on the street what dyslexia means and they often say that when we see "was" they see "saw" or we see "James" and they see "Semaj". This is an issue that some deal with it, but not all. For some it is only certain letters, some see the letters upside down, some see one word differently in a sentence, others see every word in a sentence. You can see it is quite varied. Steinke urges teachers and parents to help raise awareness. She and I recommend "Overcoming Dyslexia" by Sally Shaywitz. She and her partners from Yale are dealing with different learning tools for children.

I wish this was available to guide me when as a young teacher, counselors told me "don't worry about it, she's dyslexic". Times have changed and so have I.

I never accepted this as a response as an administrator, but sadly when a supposed expert talks like that to parents, especially young parents or those that work out of the home every day, they have a tendency to feel "okay that's the way it is". Help your kid the best you can. If you think you, yourself, are dyslexic, it can still be improved. Good internet searches may lead you in a way to start.

## Historic Plaque Dedication

14th Ward Alderman Edward M. Burke; Carla Knorowski, Chief Executive Officer of the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library Foundation; Mary Brennan, a representative of the Daughters of the American Revolution and Planning Commissioner David L. Reifman attended the rededication of a pair of historic plaques which commemorate the location where Chicago was incorporated as a town and Abraham Lincoln was nominated for president of the United States.

Gifted to the City in the early 20th century by the Daughters of the American Revolution, the 30- by 50-inch brass plaques honor the location of the Sauganash Hotel where Chicago was incorporated as a town and, later, the Wigwam convention hall, on the southeast corner of Wacker Drive and Lake st.

The wood-framed Sauganash Hotel was built in 1831 by pioneer Mark Beaubien as an addition to his log cabin. The white, two-story hotel served as the social center of the growing town and hosted monthly village board meetings from 1833 to 1835. Named for the Potawatomi-British fur trader Sauganash, also known as Billy Caldwell, the hotel remained in operation, including an 1837 stint as the city's first theater, until it burned down in 1851.

Nine years later, the Wigwam was erected on the same location for the 1860 Republican National Convention. Designed by Chicago

Water Tower architect W. W. Boyington and financed by civic leaders, the two-story, gas-lit building was the first structure in the country to be built for a presidential convention.

It was also the country's first presidential convention hall to have on-site telegraph equipment and to accommodate the public in large numbers, seating more than 10,000. Lincoln was nominated on the Republican ticket in the Wigwam on May 18, 1860, before being elected president 157 years ago this month. The Wigwam was later converted to retail uses before likely being destroyed by fire in 1867 or during the Great Chicago Fire of 1871.

"As a student of Chicago history, I am pleased to see these beautifully refurbished plaques rededicated at this historic site," said Ald. Burke, the co-author of Inside the Wigwam, Chicago Presidential Conventions 1860-1996.

"I was proud to champion the decision to once again place them on public display after a hiatus of many years. They now join other markers, statutory and memorials situated throughout our neighborhoods that tell the story of our City's history."

The site of Sauganash Hotel and Wigwam was dedicated an official Chicago landmark on in 2002. The plaques honoring the buildings are affixed on a five-foot-tall, cast stone marker on the pedestrian median on Wacker near Lake. The marker was designed by Landmarks Commission staff and installed by the Chicago Department of Transportation.

as well as members of the First Ladies Health Initiative of Chicago. Currently, more than 116,000 people are waiting for organs nationally. In Illinois, approximately 4,700 people are on the waiting list. Sadly, about 300 people in this state die each year because organs are not available. ## Teen Birthrate Hits New Low

The Chicago Department of Public Health announced teen births have reached a new historic low. In 2015, the most recent year for which the data is available, there were 27.5 births per 1,000 females aged 15 to 19 years old, a more than 67 percent drop from the 85.2 rate in 1999. Since 2010, Chicago has seen declines in teen births across all racial and ethnic groups. African American teens, who historically face greater disparities regarding teen births, have been the greatest decline, from more than 72 births per 1,000 females to 34.9. Chicago's teen birthrate is higher than the national average but continues to aggressively close the gap, dropping 20 per-

cent more than national rate since 2010. Research has shown that teen birth and unintended pregnancies increase the chance low birth weight and infant mortality. Studies also show that approximately 38 percent of teen mothers earn a high school diploma and less than 2 percent earn a college degree by the age of 30. CDPH's Healthy Adolescents and Teens program offers education on birth control abstinence and health relationships in select CPS high schools, in addition to testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections. ## Assessor's Office Reports Progress

Please allow the Cook County Assessor's Office to address recent inaccurate reports and misconceptions about property assessment in Cook County.

The Civic Consulting Alliance is studying the assessment and appeal processes, including Assessor's Office procedures, assessment models, the Cook County Board Review and other aspects. Assessor Joseph Berrios welcomed the CCA study.

The study's timing has been questioned, and Assessor Berrios criticized for it. However, critics and media have ignored the fact that CCA does not report to the Assessor. He has absolutely no authority over their timetable.

To be clear, the Assessor's only responsibility is to fully cooperate with the study. He continues to do that and provides study personnel with office space. Assessor Berrios respects the CCA study which, unlike others, includes assessment professionals.

Accomplishments of the Berrios administration are disregarded. For example, it has six straight years of on-time assessments leading to timely tax bills. Previously, bills were late for 34 years.

On-time revenue for schools, etc. eliminates \$5 to \$6 million countywide in monthly interest on borrowing while awaiting revenue. In the last 13 years before Berrios was elected, 39 late months accumulated. Berrios' zero late months saved taxpayers many tens of millions of dollars, and counting.

Past assessors left erroneous exemptions unchecked. Assessor Berrios designed the law with which he recovers this would-be lost money and returns it to school districts, communities and municipalities. To date, \$47.2 million has been billed.

More than a year ago,

Berrios conceived and began to help pass legislation giving lower-income homeowners greater flat-rate, money-saving exemptions. The Berrios-engineered exemption expansion became law in August.

For appeals awareness, CCAO has raised annual community appearances to 238 - and 81 percent are in areas with lower-market homes.

None of these things were acknowledged in recent reports.

When discussing taxes, please keep in mind the important fact that *assessors don't set tax rates*. Also, the State Equalizer has gone down dramatically since Joseph Berrios became Assessor, an indication of fair assessments.

The Cook County Assessor's Office again states, unequivocally, that its estimated property values are fair and accurate. There is no rampant overassessment of lower-market homes or under-valuation of higher ones.

Previous administrations employed the same assessment model we use, and they were not criticized. Berrios is criticized, without regard for his tremendous Assessor's Office improvements - despite staff cuts of 31 percent. The timing is odd.

Some observers without assessment experience say Cook County should use a recently developed assessment model. In fact, after initial enthusiasm for that new model, we found it did not work when full implementation was attempted.

With 47 years of public service, Joseph Berrios knows assessing Cook County's 1.85 million properties is difficult. But he gets the job done, works to ensure fairness and to improve the system. Thank you.
