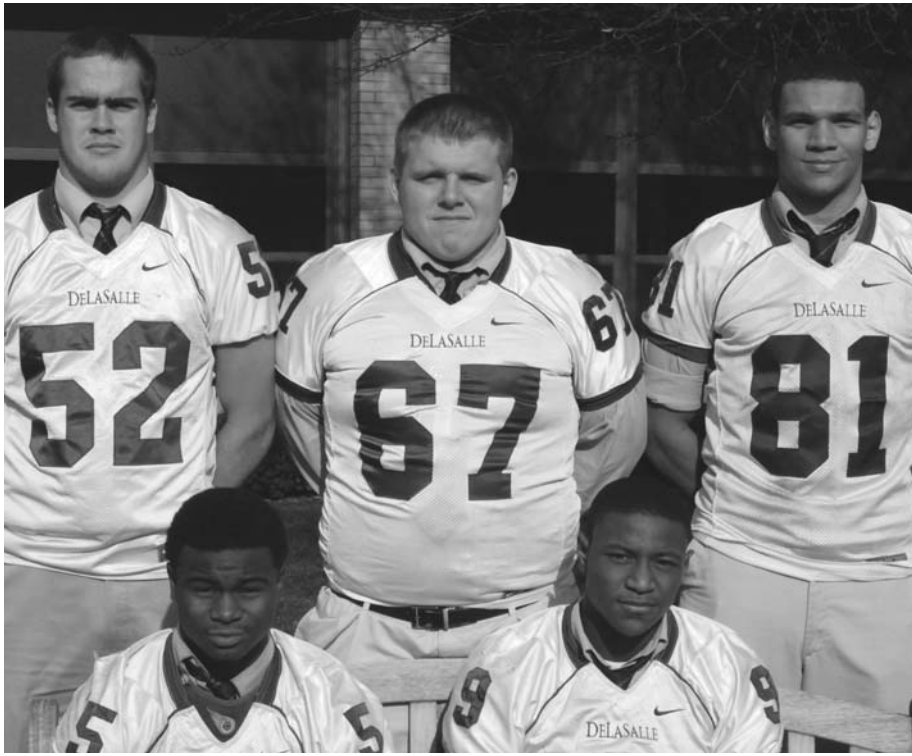


# HAPPY NEW YEAR TO ALL

De La Salle Institute announces that five of its student-athletes have earned places on the 2011 All-Chicago Catholic League White Football Team: seniors James Buss (Archer Heights), Jordan Fisher, Christo-

pher Lisenby and Jared Philip and sophomore Mikale Wilbon. Buss, who finished with 48 tackles as nose guard, was chosen the Chicago Catholic League White Defensive Player of the Year.

Fisher, a linebacker, was the leading tackler with 87. Philip, an offensive and defensive lineman, finished with 33 tackles, one pass defended and one forced fumble. Lisenby, who was the punter along with playing tight end and defensive end, had six receptions for 170 yards and three touchdowns. Defensively, he had 17 tackles, while he averaged 30.2 per kick.

Wilbon, a running back, rushed 215 times for 1,634 and 14 touchdowns with a 7.6 yards per carry.
