The European Union Center and the Center for Translation Studies at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign welcomed winners of the Illinois High School Translation Competition in European Union languages to the event, "2013 Translation Day at Illinois: Celebrating Languages" on May 2nd.

Students from ten Illinois high schools spent the day on the U of I campus learning about translation and interpretation as professions, as well as how the European Union functions with 23 official languages. The students were required to translate a text about the EU

winning the 2012 Nobel Peace Prize from an official EU language into English.

The European Union was established in Italy on January 1, 1958 with the Treaty of Rome. It was proposed by the French Minister Robert Schuman and by the Italian Prime Minister Alcide De Gasperi, to foster peace, economic cooperation, and - above all - to put an end to the millenary wars among the European Nations.

In the beginning, the Founding Nations of the EU were Belgium, France, Italy, the Netherlands, and West Germany. Over the years, many other European Nations have joined the

Union. After two millennia, imitating the United States, the European Union began the year 2000 with one currency, the Euro.

Two winners per school were based on appropriate terminology, use of idiomatic expressions, and overall accuracy. The winners from this year's competition translated from French, Italian, Portuguese, and Spanish. The two first and second place students from Kelly High School were Margarita Juarez and Lilliana Granda, for the Italian language, the glorious language of Dante, known as the "Divine Poet."

The Illinois High School Translation Competition and 2013 Translation Day are organized by the European Union Center, a U.S. Department of Education Title VI National Resource Center and European Union Center of Excellence, and the Center for Translation Studies in the School of Literatures, Cultures and Linguistics, with a grant from the U of I Office of Public Engagement.

Federal Help For Flooding

Congressman Dan Lipinski announced that his constituents in Will, DuPage and Cook counties hit by last month's flooding are now eligible to apply for federal assistance.

On May 10th, the president signed a disaster declaration for 11 counties in Illinois, one day after Lipinski and the Illinois delegation urged him to back the governor's request for federal aid following torrential rainstorms that damaged homes and business.

The declaration covers those affected by the severe storms and winds between April 16th and May 5th. The Federal Emergency management Agency, which administers the assistance program, has established a toll-free telephone number 800-621-FEMA (3362) or 800-462-7585.

Theater On Lake Opens Season

The Chicago Park District's Theater on the Lake: The Chicago Summer Theater Festival kicks off its 61st anniversary with a USO dance before the first of eight encore presentations from artistically diverse theater companies June 12th - Aug. 11th. Each production will be performed for five evenings at the theater at Fullerton ave. and Lake Shore drive.

The season opens with The New Colony's *The Bear Suit of Happiness* (June 12th-16th) and continues with MPAACT's *Blackademics* (June 19th-23rd); Manual Cinema's *Lula del Ray* (June 26th-30th); Theater Obbleck's *There Is a Happiness That Morning Is* (July 10th-14th); Barrel of Monkeys' *That's Weird, Grandma* (July 17th-21st); The Den Theatre's *The Quality of Life* (July 24th-28th); Jackalope Theatre's *Long Way Go Down* (July 31st - Aug. 4th); and Chicago Physical Theater's *The Chi-Town Clown Revue featuring Honeybuns* (Aug. 7th-11th).

*Sloth Bear Births
At Brookfield Zoo*



The Chicago Zoological Society with manages Brookfield Zoo announces the birth of two sloth bear cubs on Jan. 20th. The cubs have been in a maternity den with their mom, Hani, 10.

Sloth bears have a gestation period of six to seven months. At birth, the cubs weighed less than one pound and could fit in the palm of a hand. Now at 3 1/2 months old, they weigh approximately 10 to 20 pounds. Sloth bear cubs are born blind and rely on their mom for

nutritional needs. They leave the den at about two to three months of age and remain with their mother for about two to three years.

Zoo guests will be able to witness one of the most intriguing behavioral transits of this species: a mother sloth bear carrying her young on her back. Hani will continue to carry her cubs until they are about a third her size. This is the first successful litter of sloth bears at Brookfield Zoo.
