Addax Birth At Brookfield Zoo



Brookfield Zoo announces the birth of an addax antelope on June 7th and several more are expected in the coming weeks. The male calf, which weighed 19 pounds, was born on exhibit so many zoo guests were able to witness its first moments of life. The birth is a significant one for the species as it is near the brink of extinction in the Sahara deserts of Africa. Nearly 200 addax live in 19 accredited North American zoos, with about 300 living in the wild. The pairing of Sara, 4, the mom, and Winston,

11, the sire was based on a breeding recommendation from the Association of Zoos and Aquariums' Addax Species Survival Plan. Brookfield Zoo has exhibited addax antelope since 1935 and has contributed 141 calves to the North American population since 1941, when it had the first calf born in the United States. Other members of the addax herd at Brookfield Zoo are females Martha, 13; Mali, 5 and Mona, 15 - all expecting calves this summer. They can be seen on exhibit along the 31st Street animal habitats.

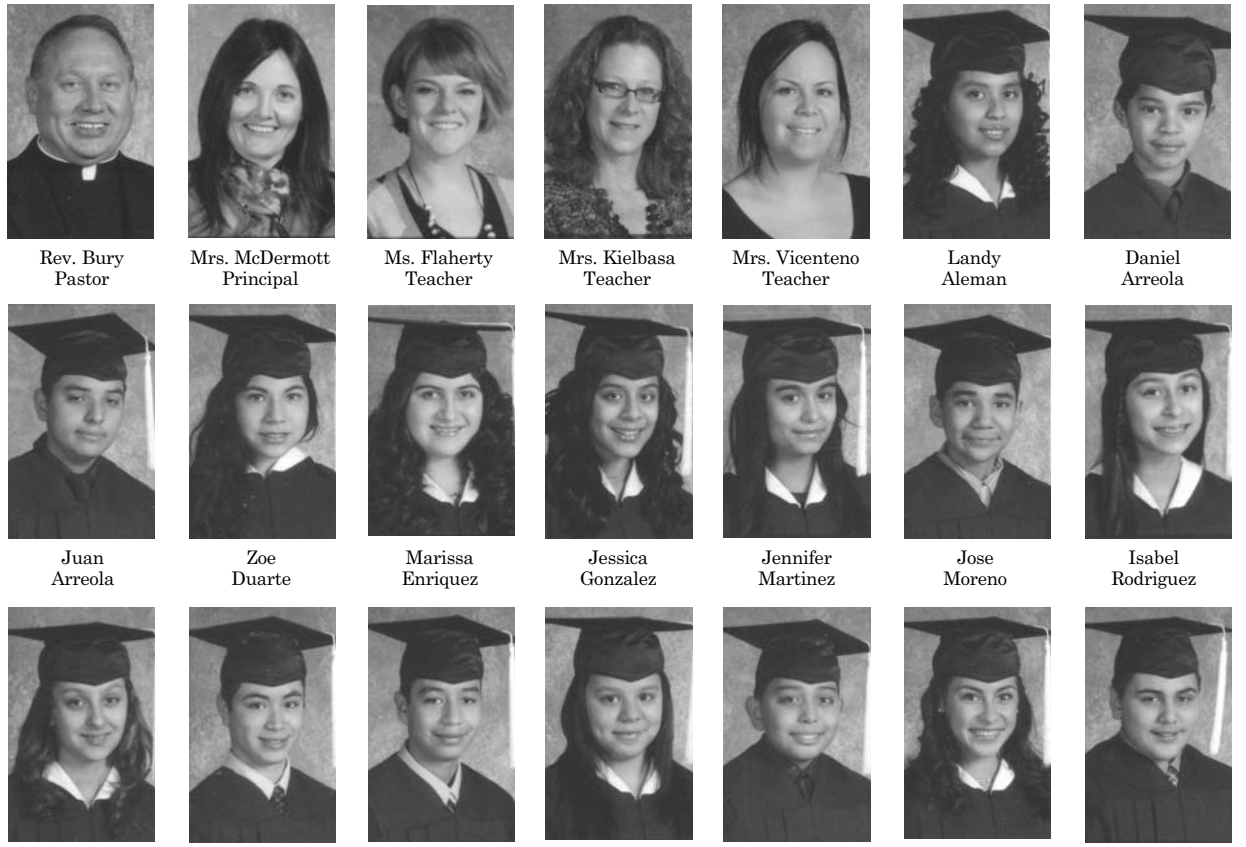

Innovation Lab At Library Center

Already used by a variety of industries from retail to banking to universities, Innovation labs offer organizations a place to test new ideas for services, programs and products.

The third floor space will allow CPL to experiment with new ideas to be more customer focused and adapt to the community's changing needs.

The first innovation experiment is the Maker Lab, part of the growing movement of collaborative learning environments in which people share knowledge and resources to design, create and build items.

Created in partnership with the Museum of Science and Industry, the Maker Lab offers the public an introduction to technology and equipment which are enabling new forms of personal manufacturing and business opportunities.

After the six month run, the Library will evaluate the project to determine the ability to bring the project, or elements of

it, to neighborhood branches.

The Lab will offer access to a variety of software such as Trimble Sketchup, Inkscape, Meshlab, Makercam and equipment including three 3D Printers, two laser cutters, as well as milling machine and vinyl cutter.

In addition to Open Lab hours during which patrons can work with staff members to master new software and create personal projects, a variety of programs and workshops will be offered throughout the seven day schedule. Family workshops will be offered every Sunday afternoon to foster invention, creation and exploration of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math) the focus of this year's Summer Learning Challenge.
