

Vaccinations At United Center

A new federal vaccination site will open at the United Center, Madison and Wood st. on Tuesday, March 9th.

The site will have the capacity to administer 6,000 doses per day, all of which will be provided directly by the federal government and not taken out of the state or city's allotment.

Seniors will have first access to appointments before the site opens, and if appointments remain available after seniors have had their exclusive registration period, any remaining slots will be open to any Illinoisans eligible under the state's guidelines. After March 9th, registration will continue to be open for all Illinoisans eligible in the state's Phase 1B+.

Registration will begin Thursday, March 4th at 8:30 a.m. at [Zocdoc.com/vaccine](https://www.zocdoc.com/vaccine) or by calling (312) 746-4835. Through a city partnership with Uber 20,000 will be available.
