Catholic Scouting Emblems Presentation

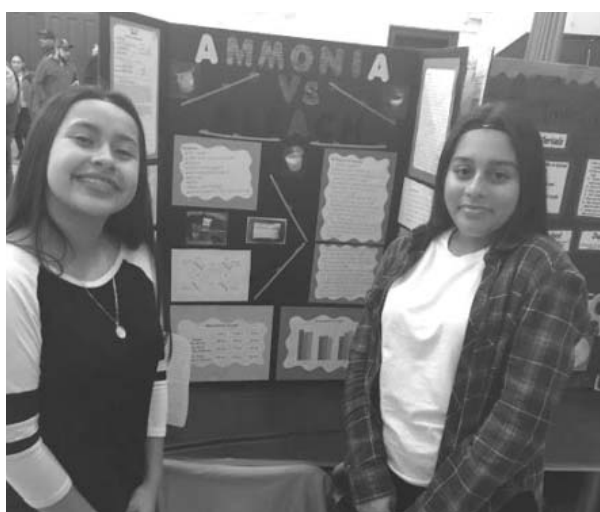

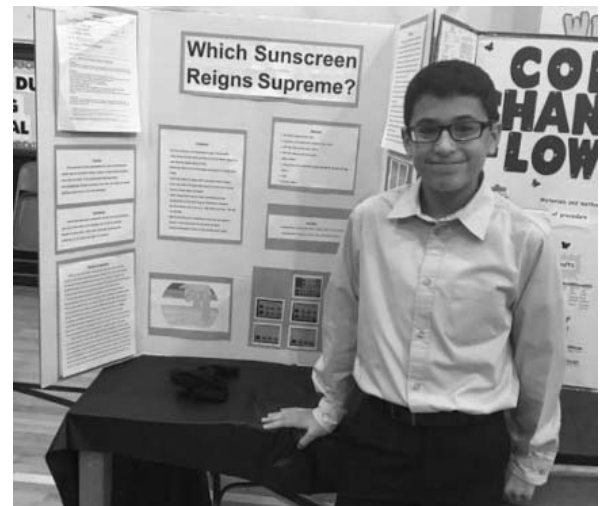
Regional Honors At Science Fair

Day Of Recollection At Five Holy Martyrs

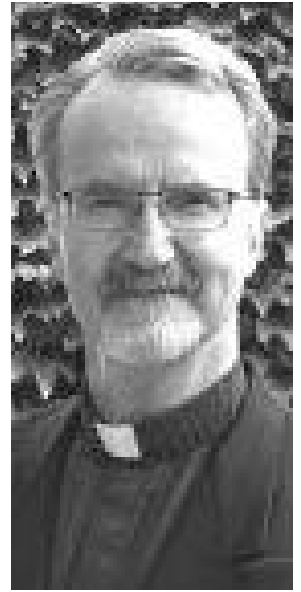

MWRD Supports SimCity Events



MWRD Commissioner Kari K. Steele reviewed the St. Mary of the Woods' Future City exhibit and many more during her visit.

The Chicago regionals of the Future City Competition which introduces 6th, 7th and 8th grade students to engineering with SimCity™ software was held at the University of Illinois at Chicago campus. Students from across the country had the opportunity to design cities with simulation software, build scale models, write essays and give oral presentations on their design.

Metropolitan Water Reclamation District Commissioner Kari K. Steele and five MWRD

employees participated in the events. Terence Maiellaro, Senior Mechanical Engineer; Michael Zigulich, Associate Civil Engineer and Lou Storino, Principal Civil Engineer, participated as preliminary round judges. They also have an opportunity to serve as an Essay and Computer Model Judge prior to the event where they review and score essays and Sim City computer models.

This year's theme was "The Age-Friendly City" and participants were tasked with envisioning an urban environment that keeps older adults active, engaged and independent. Working in a team with an educator and STEM mentor, students present their vision of the future through a virtual city design; write

a 1,500 word essay; build a scale model of their city with recycled materials; and present a short presentation to a panel of STEM professionals. US regional winners will face

off at the finals in Washington, DC in February, where they are joined by a growing roster of international teams, including those from Canada, Egypt and China.

Recruitment For Police Department

Mayor Rahm Emanuel and Chicago Police Department Superintendent Eddie Johnson announced that 83 officers have been deployed to their district assignments, as part of the plan to grow the Department by 970 police officers. New officers will be deployed to districts each month into 2019.

After successfully completing their training at the Academy, they have now completed their initial field training and are being sent to their first district detail. The new officers will benefit from the new in-service training requirement, which begins with 16-hours of mandatory training and will necessitate that all members take 40 hours of continuing education annually by 2021. These officers also benefited from a new cultural awareness course taught at the DuSable Museum of African American History, and new de-escalation, crisis intervention and procedural justice modules.

The City is now accept-

ing applications for the next Police Entry Exam. The ongoing "Be the Change" recruitment campaign which reflects the belief that this new generation of police officers will lay the groundwork for more diverse department and be future leaders who define how police support, protect and work together with communities.

Lawyers Offer Phone Advice

Attorneys with the Chicago Bar Association's Call-A-Lawyer Program will be available to take calls from the public and offer brief legal advice on Saturday, Feb. 17th from 9 a.m. to noon at (312) 554-2001. Call-A-Lawyer events are typically held on the third Saturday of each month in the morning hours.

Citizens can call in and briefly explain their situation to an attorney who will then work to suggest self-help strategies or provide advice to help resolve their issues.
