

CPS Announces New Programming For Nathan Davis Elementary

Chicago Public Schools announced a \$7.5 million multi-year investment to expand high-quality academic programs for nearly 4,000 students at seven elementary schools. The investment will support staffing, training and learning resources for programs including International Baccalaureate, STEAM, Fine and Performing Arts, and Dual Language over the next six years.

Programming will benefit a student population that is approximately 89 percent low-income and 29 percent Black and 64 percent Latinx.

IB: More than 20,000 students at 64 schools will have access to International Baccalaureate programs.

STEM/STEAM: More than 21,000 students at 46 schools will engage in modern STEM and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics) programming.

Fine & Performing Arts: More than 41,000 students at 72 schools will benefit from comprehensive arts instruction.

Dual Language: Students at 43 schools will develop literacy and fluency in two languages. A new program will be created at Nathan Davis Elementary School, Pershing rd. and Sacramento.
