

The local school principals and their Local School Councils have an extremely difficult job in setting the Budget for their schools. The central Board will not let a school go without electric or gas, but they have left it to the local schools on how to staff their buildings. The principals are restricted by Union agreement on compensation and minimum number of staff.

The schools have received a lump-sum determined by the Board's estimate of attendance for the next school year. The school does have a chance to contest this if they have proof.

While everyone is broke, there is still the possibility of a strike and the principals know it is very unlikely they will receive any more funds. Therefore, the principals must keep money on the side to help pay for any

The School Board has allowed slightly more per student for those schools that have experienced staff. After this has been agreed upon with Local School Councils, the principal must sit and wait

because the money actually comes in on the 20th school day. This is the final amount they will receive as the total per student fund is finalized. This further compli-

cates a principal's job in that they may have lost or gained students since the Board's projection. Then after the 20th day any student that comes to the school does not come with funds.

This adds to a problem I had as a principal because after the 20th day was when certain Charter Schools transferred out students, these students came without funds because the Charter School already got the funds for these students. If you had a large school like I did, the influx could be such that you now had overcrowded classrooms with no funds

to hire. The 20th day rule is completely within Board rules and from talking to present principals, many of them still have this problem. Due to the small budget, the principal when taking into consideration of the experience and educational background of those applying.

At one time the principal just went to the best candidate, they did not have to consider if they had a Master's Degree or family insurance plan, which now sadly the principal must take into consideration and sometimes just take the least costly candidate, though publicly I'm sure no one wants to admit this. The truth is, you must pay your bills or you'll be the one fired.

Vets Preference

Governor Signs

Governor Rauner signed House Bill 3122 on July 28th creating the Veterans Preference in Private Employment Act, allowing private employers to voluntarily establish preference in employment for certain veterans.

The law, sponsored by Rep. Robert W. Pritchard (R-Hinckley), aims to reduce the unemployment rate for the more than 800,000 veterans in Illinois. By amending the Illinois Human Rights Act, it allows an employer to voluntarily establish a preference for hiring veterans as long as there is a publicly posted policy that is applied uniformly for all employment decisions regarding the hiring, promotion or retention of employees.

The act applies to veterans of the five service branches, their reserve components, and the Illinois National Guard. Illilaw currently includes a veterans' preference policy for public sector employment and protections against discrimination based on military status.
