Silvana Tabares, newly elected representative for the 21st district of the Illinois House of Representatives visited Kelly High School on Jan. 24th to meet with students and staff and discuss educational and neighborhood issues.

A Democrat and Brighton Park native, she spoke to Mr. Brian Halberg's law class about her background, education, work experience, and eventual path to elected office, while questioning students about their experiences working for campaigns at the local, state and national level.

She also observed students preparing for the Cook County Mock Trial Competition and met with members of the Mikva Challenge Club. Tabares's visit was a wonderful way to allow

an elected representative of the larger Kelly community to experience first-hand some of the programs and opportunities the school offers.

The visit also allowed Kelly students, some of whom are registered voters, the chance to have a direct conversation with a state legislator and express their concerns about issues they believe are important to their community.

Students found the visit to be a great opportunity for them to learn more about real world politics and were inspired by her story.

"The most important thing I learned from Rep. Tabares is that if you keep working towards

your goals, you can accomplish anything," the sophomore Arely Martinez said. "It is inspiring to see a person from my own neighborhood giving back to the community that provided her with the opportunities to succeed."

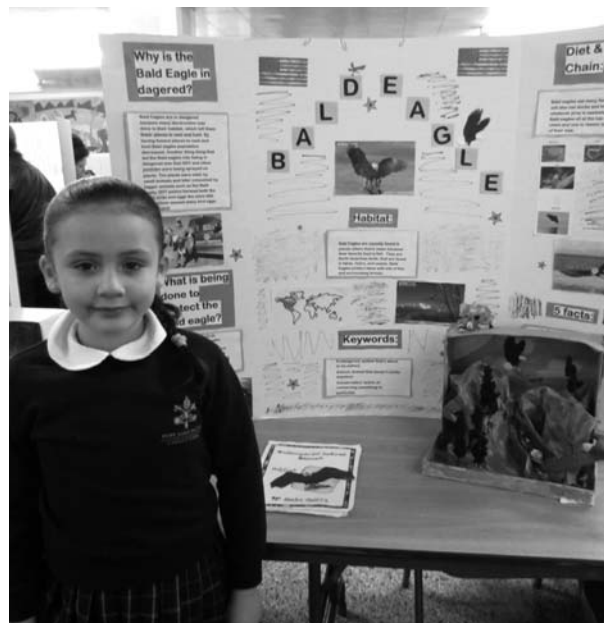
