## Teacher Furloughs



In an effort to save money, the CPS school system is giving teachers furloughs. The Sun-Times reported giving furlough days will save CPS \$30 million by closing schools on this Friday, March 25th, and Friday, April 8th. The Chicago Teachers' Union has also issued a warning that they may call a work action on April

What does this tell our kids? Certainly not the rhetoric about the importance of education. When talking budget, school is scheduled for these days, which means parents need to arrange for their children, by either taking a day off of work and thus losing their salary and some will be forced to pay for a sitter.

Ironically, the leadership of some of these groups are among the people who complain that people deserve a higher wage. April 8th has been scheduled since last summer as a day of non-attendance, so that day should not be as big a problem. Our students are not

as naïve as you might think. Several high school kids asked me how can we blame the governor who has only been here a few months and we don't blame the legislature that has been in charge for many years -- that is hard to answer. Another interesting fact one astute student told me was that while the Board is saving money (estimated at \$30 million) that is money out of the system, that won't be taxed, and can't buy things that could be taxed. Remember kids have no school on Good Friday, or April 8th, but watch the news about the decision for April 1st.
