## 36th Anniversary of '79 Papal Visit

Saint John Paul II holds a special place in the hearts and homes of the people of Five Holy Martyrs Parish, as well as the Brighton Park community on the southwest side of Chicago, since he celebrated a Mass on Oct. 5th, 1979 at a special altar erected in our parish parking lot specifically for his visit.

The Mass was attended by thousands of people who crowded the lot and the streets before dawn just to catch a glimpse of our Holy Father and be a part of that historical day.

The main part of this altar still remains in our lot and a Mass commemorating the anniversary of Saint John Paul II's visit is celebrated at this altar every year on the first Sunday of October. The Pope John Paul II Centrum Committee of our Parish worked tirelessly to raise over \$100,000 in order to renovate this altar to make it a more permanent fixture in our community for individuals to come and honor Saint John Paul II

in prayer.

The 36th anniversary Mass commemorating Saint John Paul II's visit to Five Holy Martyrs Parish will be celebrated on Sunday, Oct. 4th at 11 a.m. at the Papal Altar in the Parish parking lot. This bi-lingual Polish-English celebration is well attended by many cultural, civic and Parish organizations - a beautiful representation of Polonia in Chicago.

The main celebrant and homilist at the Mass will be Rev. Pawel Bandurski, Provincial of the Society of Christ Fathers in North America. In case of inclement weather, the mass will be celebrated in the church.

During this year's Papal Anniversary Mass, it will be the fifth time that we will not only pray and thank God for the gift and presence of Saint John Paul II among us, but we will also pray to him, asking him to continually bless us and intercede for us. For 31 years, Pope John Paul II has been with us spiritually during these anniversary Masses, but since 2011, he has been with us during the Mass physically - in the presence of his blood.

On Sept. 24th, 2011, Five Holy Martyrs Parish was very fortunate to have received a relic of Saint John Paul II from His Eminence, Stanislaw Cardinal Dziwisz, the Archbishop of Krakow, Poland, and the former personal secretary to Pope John Paul II. The relic is a drop of Saint John Paul II's blood on a

cloth protected by a lunula, a small, round glass encasement. The lunula has been mounted into a reliquary, a vessel in which a relic is held and exposed.

Since receiving this relic, Five Holy Martyrs Parish has begun a new tradition on the first weekend of every month by offering up our petitions to God through his intercession and venerating his relic at the weekend Masses; reciting a prayer to him as a community of believers; and finally by receiving a special blessing with the relic at the end of Mass. Immediately after the Sunday 9 a.m. English Mass and the 11 a.m. Polish Mass, parishioners and friends are invited to gather in the Bishop Abramowicz Parish Hall for cake, coffee, and fellowship.

We hope that everyone will mark their calendars to attend this unique celebration at 11 a.m. on Sunday, Oct. 4th. It is a wonderful reason for family and friends to come back to Brighton Park and reminisce. All cultural, civic and neighborhood organizations are invited to attend and walk in the entrance procession. Refreshments will be served in the Bishop Abramowicz Hall immediately after the Mass.

The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District conducted the ribbon cutting for the Thornton Composite Reservoir which will collect up to 7.9 billion gallons of sewage and storm water. The collected water will be pumped to the Calumet Water Reclamation Plant for treatment. The MWRD's Tunnel and Reservoir Plan (TARP) consists of three reservoirs: Thornton, Majewski and McCook and over 100 miles of tunnels

to eventually accommodate over 20.5 billion gallons of untreated water.

## Latinos Appeal For Blood Donations

In conjunction with Blood Cancer Awareness Month and National Hispanic Heritage Month, Chicago Aldermen gathered at City Hall to kick off their "Dona Sangre, Salva 3 Vidas" campaign, and call for increased volunteers to donate blood and join the bone marrow registry, among the Latino population.

Though Latinos make up the largest minority of the US population at 17% (24% in Chicago), they make up less than 4% of blood donors. Yet majority of Latinos (nearly 60%) have type O blood, the universal blood type.

Margaret Vaughn, Government Affairs Director of the IL Coalition of Community Blood Centers explained, "Latino blood contains certain antibodies, unique to the Latino population, which are critical when an exact antigen match is required for a transfusion."

While Illinois' blood centers rely heavily on all blood types, Vaughn explained how type O positive blood is especially valuable. It is the most common blood type, which means it's most in demand, but if you have type O blood, only a type O transfusion will work for you. However, people with other blood types can receive type O blood and it is often used to treat accident victims when there is not time to test blood type.

Javier Macias of the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society explained how his organization exists to find cures and ensure access to treatments for blood cancer patients and how blood donation plays a critical role.

There is also a great demand for Latinos to join the national bone marrow registry. Thousands of patients each year are in need of a marrow/stem cell transplant for blood related diseases and a patient is more likely to find a match from someone of their own ethnic background. Yet, Latinos make up only 10% of the

bone marrow registry. If you are between the ages of 18-44, a simple cheek swab and can be done at a registry drive or by simply going online to [www.bethematch.com](http://www.bethematch.com) and a kit will be sent to your home.

5 year old Lucas Cervone of Chicago, is in the battle of his life with Leukemia and his parents are hoping to find a bone marrow match. Because of his mixed Caucasian and Latino background, it is especially challenging finding a viable donor.

A blood drive and bone marrow register drive is being held at Gordon's Ace Hardware 444 N. Orleans on Saturday, Sept. 26th from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. To learn more, go to the "Lucas Bear Heroes Community" Facebook page.

## "Visit By Foreign Dignitaries"

When a foreign dignitary visits the United States, how do you approach it with your students? Do you guide the students or ignore the visit? What if that leader was going to address both the UN General Assembly and the Joint Houses of Congress after a meeting at the White House with the President? You must assume it would be a significant political leader and the students should be made aware of the issues. The situation becomes even more enticing when that leader is the religious leader of about 1.3 billion worldwide and up to 81.6 million in the U.S.

There is no doubt we are talking about the Papal visit that will go to Washington, New York and Philadelphia. Educators should be aware that the 81.6 million Americans that have allegiances to the Pope have no religious ties with his non-theological beliefs. He will say many things that the press will make sound like it's a big deal, but educators must understand the belief in Papal infallibility only pertains to theology.

Educators to do a good job must sort this out. For example, if the Pope

speaks about global warming, it is his opinion, not that of "The Church". We must all be careful because the press will play to the "lapsed Catholics". It is more sensational. Pope Francis has shown he will make a two minute off the cuff statement that takes his people hours to try and explain. We do not want to give false interpretations of what might be said.

Teachers and parents get your ducks in a row or they will believe the headlines. The papers will show the Pope at the 9/11 Monument with Muslim clerics and the Pope at the White House with a guest list that contains many anti-Catholic guests of the President. Help your students understand that they want the photo op, the Pope is just a guest.

Interesting times -- if you are not up to it I pity our students. But maybe if you are in that situation, you should ignore the trip this week. The vast majority of the students in our community are at least nominally Catholic and they and their families will have some interest in the vast media exposure. Do your best. Remember an honest I don't know is a legitimate answer.
