

Naming Contest For Snowplows

The City of Chicago is holding its third annual “You Name A Snowplow” contest. Submissions are open until Jan. 4th, one name per person, limit 50 characters. Entries can be made online at shovels.chicago.gov.

The first phase involves gathering submissions, the second phase involves voting on the top 50 finalists, which will start on Jan. 10th. The top six winning names will represent one snowplow in each of the city’s snow districts. Previous winning names include “Skilling It”, “CTRL-SALT-DELETE”, and “Mrs. O’Leary’s Plow”. Residents are encouraged to think creatively and submit their suggestions.
