Glessner House Museum, 1800 S. Prairie ave. will conduct Prairie Avenue Walking Tours on Sunday, Sept. 23rd from 2 to 4 p.m.

This tour will proceed down historic Prairie Avenue, once home to Mar-Field, George Pullman, and many other business and social leaders of the late 19th century. View the surviving mansions, and see historic photos of some of the homes that have been

Highlights will include a tour of the Simmerling Gallery of Prairie Avenue History and an interior tour of the National Historic Landmark Second Presbyterian Church with its collection of nine Tiffany windows.
Tour guide William

Tyre is the executive di-

rector and curator of Glessner House museum and author of Chicago's Historic Prairie Avenue. The cost is \$25 person.

The Architecture of Glessner House will be featured on the third Saturday of the month through December from 10 a.m. to 12 noon.

Controversial at the time of its completion in 1887, it foreshadowed the development of modern residential architecture, and architect H.H. Richardson had a profound impact on architects to follow, including Louis Sullivan and Frank Lloyd Wright. Attendees will see areas not included on public tours as well as objects rarely shown, including Richardson's original sketch. The cost is \$25 person.


