The National Conventions

The Republican Party is having its convention now in Cleveland and the Democratic Convention will be next week in Philadelphia. Some of your students may have questions about this. What it is and why it is a big deal.

The truth is many of us have no idea what is going on and even those who understand the who understand the process, realize it is no longer the big deal it once was. There was a time when the parties actually nominated their candidates at these meetings.

Now we clearly know who the candidates are, so there is no big drama for a television event. The fact is, there will be less televised convention than ever before.

Most people are not interested enough to watch vast hours of this programming, which, in reality, are just long pep rallies. You probably don't know nor care much about party platforms. which are long statements that enumerate what the parties stand for.

At first we think Thank God, there is less TV coverage, but in real-

ity, this makes the TV announcers even more powerful because they will reduce hours of speeches to the 20 second sound bites. They will tell you what the people said, which may or may not be controlled by their personal bias and just tell us what fits their

I'll give you an example, if you listen to the press, Pope Francis has made great changes in the Catholic Church, but listen to reports from Catholic bishops and they say nothing substantive has changed, except the perception of the non-Catholic press.

The news networks have found out that very few people will change their minds because of the speeches or the platforms. The one thing that can make a difference would be if the

protests got out of hand.
Those of us who
remember the 1968 convention may recall that the later research agrees that the protesters helped Nixon easily beat Humphrey. I am writing this on a calm Sunday. If protests become disruptive, I will address how to help your kids with it in the future.

So if you have the relationship with your student-aged children that they ask questions, suggest they actually read the speeches not lis-ten to the "talking heads". If they watch it on the news, switch channels to get a different perspective.

See if you can find out what the candidates really said. Even better, if they are super interested, there is a cable channel that is showing the conventions gavel to gavel without commercials or commentaries. Imagine, thinking for ourselves.
