Scholarships For Catholic Education

The Big Shoulder's Fund is offering a three-year scholarship that enables qualifying families currently attending non-Catholic schools to send each elementary age student to participating Catholic schools for \$150 month, or to participating Catholic High schools for \$300 month.

"Our Access Scholarship program will enable even more children to have the opportunity of a quality education in neighborhoods across the city, which is at the core of our mission," said Joshua Hale, president and chief executive officer of the Big Shoulders Fund. "Our donors have long championed Catholic schools for the children of working class families in Chicago, and this new scholarship program

Big Shoulder will provide \$6.5 million in additional funding to help 1,100 inner-city students through the new program, in addition to its existing scholarships supporting over 5,000 students. In total, Big Shoulders provides \$12 to \$14 million in annual support for the city's Catholic Schools.

"I was able to send my son Ricky to Pope John Paul II School because of the Access Scholarship," said Edith Trevino. "We've been very happy and my son has made a lot of progress in just the short time he's been there, especially in reading and math. I've never seen my son so excited to go to school and he has made many new friends."

"We encourage parents to contact their local Catholic school for more details and to enroll," said Tom Zbierski, Senior Director of Scholarship Programs. "We have great Catholic schools with longstanding programs that have sent thousands of students on to successful high school and college careers."

2.1 Million Books Read This Summer

Mayor Rahm Emanuel and Library Commissioner Brian Bannon announced that a record breaking 71,260 children and young teens read 2.1 million books as part of Rahm's Readers, the Chicago Public Library's Summer Learning Challenge. Last summer, 60,232 children read more than 1.5 million books.

This result means that Mayor Emanuel, Commissioner Bannon and Library Board member and former Chicago Bear Israel Idonije would jump in Lake Michigan in March as part of the Polar Plunge benefitting the Special Olympics.

This summer's program was entitled "Full STEAM Ahead" and focused on Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math skills through programs offered at 79 CPL locations.

Program partners Museum of Science and Industry, the Art Institute of Chicago and the Goodman Theatre offered programs at the Library and in their locations and children were able to earn electronic badges in recognition of engaging in a myriad of activities related to those topics.

Children were also asked to record how many minutes they spent reading, as this encourages kids to take the time to try books that might be a bit more difficult, while still giving them credit for the time spent doing so.
