

Vaccination Totals For Area Residents

The Chicago Department of Health and Human Services issued a report of COVID-19 cumulative vaccinations for May 10th.

City vaccine series completed - cumulative - 953,957 doses, 35.4% of population; 1st dose - cumulative 1,268,241 doses, 47% of population.

60632: 1st dose cumulative 40,629 total, 45.2% population. Complete vaccine series 31,200 total, 34.7% population.

60638: 1st dose cumulative 24,123 total, 41.1% population. Complete vaccine series 18,842 total, 32.1% population.

60608: 1st dose cumulative 43,863 total, 54.8% population. Complete vaccine series 31,330 total, 39.1% population.

60609: 1st dose cumulative 24,487 total, 40.2% population. Complete vaccine series 18,794 total, 30.8% population.
